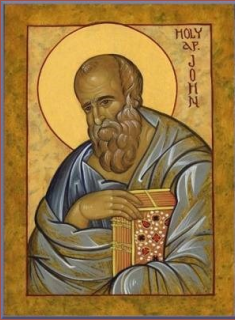

And I did this so that your faith should not depend on human philosophy but on the power of God.
